As an academic institution, data protection is a key concern for us - especially when surveying underage participants. We only collect and process the data that is necessary to achieve the intended research purposes and always endeavour to ensure the security and accuracy of the data. Personal data is therefore processed in strict compliance with the principles and requirements set out in the GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation), the Austrian Data Protection Act (DSG) and the Research Organisation Act (FOG).

General information on the action research

We want to find out more about the mobility behaviour and mobility needs of teenagers in **asperm** Seestadt. Therefore, we are interested in which means of transport are particularly popular with teenagers, which routes they choose and where they (do not) like to spend time in the Seestadt. The study was commissioned by [Wien 3420 asperm Development AG](#) (financed by the **asperm** Mobility Fund), which is responsible for infrastructure and urban development in **asperm** Seestadt. The findings will influence future planning in Seestadt and may also inspire other districts to take better account of the wishes and needs of young people in their urban and transport planning.

Participation

Teenagers can take part in three parts of the action research: As part of the sounding board, in the online survey and as part of the workshop.

Teenagers aged 12 to 19 are invited to take part in the approximately 10-minute **online survey**. The questionnaire contains a few questions about the person, everyday journeys, available means of transport, leisure activities (in **asperm** Seestadt) and personal opinions and attitudes towards certain means of transport and **asperm** Seestadt.

¹ Your personal code (6 digits) consists of the **first two letters of your first name** (e.g. Céline), your **birthday** (e.g. 24.01.2010) and the **last two digits of your mobile phone number** (...709) → CE2409. .

Participation is voluntary. **Minors under the age of 16** require the consent of a parent or guardian to participate. The survey can also be completed in analogue form. Printed questionnaires are available at our office (aspermobil LAB).

As a thank you for their commitment, participants can take part in a prize raffle (three €10 vouchers for a shop in **aspermobil** Seestadt).

The following data protection aspects are to be taken into account for participation in the online survey:

- **Personal and socio-demographic data:** The questionnaire asks about age, broad questions about the household (type of housing, household structure) and place of residence (Seestadt or not), gender, highest educational qualification, availability of means of transport, season tickets or discount cards for public transport, leisure activities, personal opinions or assessments of means of transport and **aspermobil** Seestadt. It is possible not to answer certain questions.
Contact details are required for participation in the prize draw or if you are interested in taking part in the other two parts of the study (sounding board and workshop). These will be treated confidentially in accordance with data protection regulations.
- **Results:** The questionnaire is analysed using the computer programmes Excel and SPSS, which functions are ideally suited to our study design. The results are published pseudonymised so that no conclusions can be drawn about a child / the children.
- All **project staff involved** are subject to a duty of confidentiality and are obliged to maintain data secrecy.
